



SITUATION

- Myanmar / Burma experienced torrential rains, floods, landslides, since the end of June due to the **Southwest Monsoon** and the passage of **Tropical Cyclone KOMEN** at the end of July. Assessments are on-going, but some areas remain inaccessible.
- So far **200 000 people** are known to have been badly **affected** and in need of food and shelter assistance, but this number could increase as other areas are assessed. As per Ministry of Agriculture and Irrigation data, 524 895 acres of farmland have been inundated since June, throughout the country.
- On 31 July, the President announced natural disaster zones in **Chin, Sagaing, Magway and Rakhine**.
